19TH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

Our readings this week tell us something important about God and the action of God in our lives.

Isaiah reminds us that for us to sense God's presence in our lives, we have to LISTEN. God is in the ordinary things – the challenges in getting along with others, the hardships of work., living in a less than perfect world. All of these small things, if we but hear, are God whispering to us and inviting us to grow.

Paul, by his attitude towards his own people – who were giving him the most grief many times, was teaching us to see the good in others and not be blinded by the negatives that so often get in the way.

And the Jesus of Matthew's gospel invited Peter to do something different, something strange, and something unbelievable – walk on water. Peter came forwards genuinely, panicked and forgot who it was that he was talking to and began sinking. How often does God invite me to do things that to me seem absurd, meaningless, and dumb, and I balk, only to find later that this is the very best course of action to take – trust God and go for it.

Listen carefully to the voice of God in your life with Isaiah. Imitate the attitude of Paul – see the best in others. And when God invites you to do something you don't understand – trust God. God will never let you down..
