33<sup>rd</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

God speaks to us deeply in the  
readings for this Sunday.

The Book of Proverbs reminds us that  
wisdom of the world looks to  
externals, beauty, appearance, while  
wisdom of God looks to character.  
It reminds each of us to work on what  
translates into what God asks us to  
become as opposed to what we would  
like to be or pursue.

Paul reminds the Thessalonians that  
God's coming is always unexpected.  
We are called to be aware that an  
accounting can be expected of us at  
most any time. Be prepared is good  
advice.

And the parable of the talents given to  
the three individuals is a reminder to  
each of us that God gives us  
responsibilities, cuts us a lot of slack,  
but ultimately holds us accountable.

As we reflect upon our baptismal call  
to ministry in light of the above  
words, we ask God:

1. To keep us mindful that we are part  
of God's saving plan for the world.  
There are people who will never  
experience God's care or love  
unless we mediate it to them thru  
the lives we lead.
2. To remind us daily that commit –  
ments are not dates on a calendar.  
They have to be renewed each day  
or they will simply fall apart.
3. Lastly, I am responsible for the  
proper living of my life and the  
loving of my God. But I must keep  
wits about me because I live in a  
very distracting world. .
