FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Today is the First Day of the New
Church Year – the beginning of
Advent – season of preparation for
the coming of Jesus.

ADVENT THEME:

PREPARE THE WAY OF THE LORD.

Our Advent visual portrays the
tremendous work of the season –
the leveling of mountains, filling of
valleys, making of rough ways
smooth.

As we survey the landscape of our
own Pilgrim Journey, we ask
