LAETARE SUNDAY – 4<sup>TH</sup> OF LENT

“Prepare the Way of the Lord –  
Move thru Death to Life “is our  
Theme. The 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday is the  
Sunday of rejoicing in the season  
of Penance.

The first reading recalls the final  
entrance of people into the  
Promised Land – a time of joy – a  
time of celebration. God has kept  
His Word. We are the other factor  
In the covenant of God with His  
people. God kept his part of the  
deal. How am I doing with mine.  
Examination of this point is the  
task of our Lenten journey.

Paul tells all Christians that they  
are a “New Creation.” What  
newness can I identify in my life as  
a result of my Lenten Journey thus  
far? My presence in the world –  
with my brothers and sisters in the  
Leaven Community must cause  
others to question their own values  
in light of our obvious total  
commitment to a life to come. How  
does this find expression in me?

In the parable of the prodigal son –  
we learn from each of the 3 main  
characters.

From the father, learn “Longing for  
the one who is lost.”  
From the prodigal son, learn how to  
move beyond embarrassment and  
be anxious to be forgiven and come  
back to apologize.  
And from the elder brother, learn  
how to avoid being one who holds  
a grudge and pouts.  
Thus enlightened – continue to  
have a blessed Lenten season!
