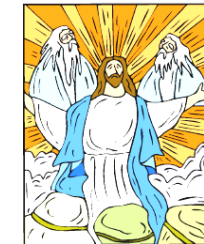

2ND SUNDAY OF EASTER

The highest form of reverence is
imitation. When Jesus called us to
"preach the gospel," He was telling us
to continue modeling what it
means to make God the top priority
of our lives.

The call is one to enter into a vision

themselves begin to wonder if in
fact we are made for life eternal.

It calls me to enter into a process of
"tough love," and facing up to life's
challenges with a measure of
grace. To be able to do this
preaches the Gospel.

My life must give evidence that
invisible values are of greater
significance than those that can be
perceived by the senses. .

To live this way is to be different.
To be different is not to be part of
the "in group." Not to be part of the
In-group is to lead a lonely life.

If we were to see following Christ
as above outlined, there would
perhaps be fewer of us indeed. But
the "Leaven" community would be
more eloquently preaching the
gospel than any homily ever to be
written or spoken.

God speaks with deeds. God spoke
and the world was made.

God's followers must speak with
deeds. In a communication
saturated world, words lose their
impact. Our presence is most
Eloquent. So be it.
