3rd SUNDAY OF EASTER

The image of the Good Shepherd is
one that is a powerful one. A flock
is bonded to its shepherd and
looks to the shepherd for nurture,
well being and protection from
harm.

The basis of security and safety is
the presence of the shepherd and
the watchful care that is part of his
job description.

Jesus describes this relationship
by saying; "I know mine and mine
know me."

Issues for me to reflect upon
include: Do I know the Shepherd?
How well do I know the Shepherd?
How much attention do I pay to the
Shepherd?

We are like the sheep of the parable
of the sheepfold. This was an
enclosure housing many flocks of
sheep for the night.

In the morning, each of the
shepherds would come in turn
before the groups of sheep and call
their sheep forward.

All the sheep would hear the voices
of each shepherd. However, they
only followed their own shepherd.

In the course of my days, many
different "shepherds" clamor for
my attention, telling me what is
good and what is bad – where to go
and how to get there.

Do I hear the Good Shepherd? Do
I listen to Him and follow Him?
