TRINITY SUNDAY - 2010

The French rationalist Voltaire once

said: "God made people to His own

Image and likeness – and people

returned the favor"

Trinity Sunday summons us to see

Who God is.

- Time is the measure of created motion, according to a "before" and an "After."

- The earth revolves on its axis once. We call that duration a day. Seven days are a week. 52 weeks a year – 100 a century.

- Everything in time moves successively – moment by moment.

- As soon as one says NOW – it's already history.
