11TH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

Our readings this weekend are deep in wisdom as we travel our pilgrim way to the kingdom.

David was chosen by God and honored incredibly. Yet adultery and murder to cover it up made sense to him. And his did both. What are some of the incredibly inappropriate things that have made sense to me? Have I learned how important it is to know I need to be watchful because I'm capable of having some dumb things make sense also.

Paul tells people of his day that justification is a gift of God. But He also reminds us that it must find expression in the life we lead – giving to others the experience of God's unconditional love for them and in this way our justification is ensured.

Lastly, Jesus points out to the Pharisee that the woman he looked down upon, in her humility, loved him more than he himself did. He did not show Christ the ordinary Courtesies whereas she, in her humble posture, loved far more than he.

How often do I remember that the people I tend to look down upon may well be a whole lot more pleasing to God than I am?

I am capable of the very best and the very worst. My love for God must move beyond words to action. And look down on no one. God sees the heart, and we must also.
